These lessons will work equally well whether you're approaching them as group or as an individual.

Each lesson appears in three sections:

Groundwork

To get the most benefit from this study, you should complete this section *before* meeting with your group. Here, you will prepare yourself to discuss the book chapter with others. If you are doing this study alone, it will serve as a warm-up for the sections that follow.

Groupwork

In the left-hand column you'll find Scripture references, quotations from the book and other sources and other material relating to the questions in the right-hand column.

Some questions in this section are general. Others are personal, relating specifically to your own workplace. If you are studying with a group, both kinds of questions are meant for discussion and interaction. Writing your responses in the blank spaces will make the study more meaningful—especially if you are doing it alone.
